This term in English we are going to look at traditional tales and focus on the 'Three Little Pigs.' We will move on to writing information leaflets about dragons later in the term.

We will kick maths off with some geometry - looking at 2D and 3D shapes. In the autumn term we were working on numbers up to 10 but later this term we will be focusing on place value (up to 20) before moving on to some addition and subtraction (up to 20). Science is all about the season of Winter and Animals (including humans). In History we are focusing on Toys and Games from the past, which should be really interesting. In Art we will be exploring colour! In RE our key question is 'Who is a Muslim and what do they believe?' Our PSHE topic is 'TEAM' and in computing the focus is digital writing. Our Music lessons this term should be fun as we are going to be 'In the Groove'!
